

Sir Michael Barber

- * Among the top 20% of teachers;
- ** Among the bottom 20% of teachers Analysis of test data from Tennessee showed that teacher quality effected student performance more than any other variable; on average, two students with average performance (50th percentile) would diverge by more than 50 percentile points over a three year period depending on the teacher they were assigned
- Source: Sanders & Rivers Cumulative and Residual Effects on Future Student Academic Achievement
